- D-37 I Live in an Alcoholic Family** - 35 minutes, discussion guide included.
Uses true-to-life stories to explore how 3 teenagers are helped to come to grips with the reality of having an alcoholic parent.
- D-38 The Truth About Alcohol** - 20 minutes, discussion guide included
Alerts students to the facts they need to know about alcohol - what it is, how it acts on the body, and why young people are so vulnerable.
- D-39 Teens and Alcohol; The Hidden Problem** - 37 minutes, discussion guide included
Teenagers tend to believe that as long as they do not end up as alcoholics, drinking cannot cause them any problems. What teens may not realize is that alcohol can make them do things they would not do if they were sober.
- D-40 Families in Trouble: Learning To Cope** - 35 minutes, discussion guide included.
Offers a process that gives students a clear direction for coping with a crisis, enabling them to see that they are not helpless.
- D-41 If Your Parents Break Up** - 31 minutes, discussion guide included.
The aftermath of divorce can leave young people with unresolved feelings of fear and anger, depression, disorientation and guilt. This program helps students come to terms with the break-up and get on with their own lives.
- D-42 Surviving Your Parents Divorce** - 35 minutes
Provides specific coping skills for adolescents who are caught in the middle of the separation/divorce process.
- D-43 Setting Goals: The Road To Achievement** - 24 minutes, discussion guide included
Provides effective guidelines for setting and achieving attainable short and long-term goals.

- D-44 Be Your Best Assertive Self: Assertiveness Training** - 29 minutes, discussion guide included. Shows students how to achieve their best self through constructive assertive behaviour by demonstrating realistic techniques.
- D-45 Building Self-Confidence** - 30 minutes, discussion guide included
Demonstrates that self-confidence is achieved in small steps: by taking a risk now and then, by learning to deal with putdowns, and through self-validation and encouragement from others.
- D-46 Dying Is Part Of Living** - 15 minutes, discussion guide included
Designed to teach students that death is not merely an end, but an integral part of life. Deals with teenagers' natural confusion, feelings of grief, and conflicting emotions which occur after the death of someone close.
- D-47 Did Jenny Have To Die? Preventing Teenage Suicide** - 40 minutes, discussion guide included. An in-depth analysis of a case of teen suicide – reveals the causes, warning signs and ways of preventing this number two cause of adolescent death.
- D-48 Breaking Up Is Hard To Do** - 26 minutes, discussion guide included
Designed to offer practical help for those who might be lingering in relationships that are unhealthy, unrewarding or destructive. It encourages teens to seek out relationships that allow them to be their best selves and emphasizes the importance of establishing healthy patterns of relating.
- D-49 Choosing To Wait** - 34 minutes, discussion guide included.
Addresses the issue of whether sexually active couples can reverse their behaviour; helps all young people, sexually active or not, to see that abstinence is an appealing and viable option.
- D-50 Real People: Teens Who Choose Abstinence** - 24 minutes, discussion guide included
Teens who are committed to abstinence discuss the personal, social and ethical reasons they themselves chose abstinence and how they view this choice as a desirable alternative.
- D-51 Dating, Sex and Trouble** - 24 minutes, discussion guide included
Program emphasizes every person's right to safeguard his or her own body, pointing out that sexual assault can be anything from unwanted kissing and touching to rape.
- D-52 When Dating Turns Dangerous** - 33 minutes, discussion guide included
This program addresses the growing problem of dating violence, why abusers act the way they do, and how the abuse gradually destroys a victim's self-esteem.
- D-53 Sexual Harassment and How To Stop It** - 28 minutes, study guide included
Alerts high school students to the facts and consequences of peer sexual harassment.

Demonstrates that what harassers consider innocent fun can have a detrimental effect on victims. Suggests steps schools can take to investigate incidents and take action against harassers.

- D-54 Human Sexuality: Wonderful Gift, Awesome Responsibility** - 25 minutes, study guide included. Issues in human sexuality are treated within the context of the dignity and goodness of all of us as sexual beings. Including the unitive and procreative meaning of sexual activity, the virtue of fidelity, and the rights of homosexual persons. For senior high school and marriage prep.
- D-55 Pray Today** - 65 minutes, study guide included
Seven segments calling teenagers to a prayerful life. Each segment is about 7 minutes long.
- D-56 Sex Has A Price Tag 2000** - 60 minutes
In this video, renowned speaker Pam Stenzel combines her personal story and extensive pregnancy counselling experience into a hard hitting look at the consequences of sexual activity outside a monogamous lifetime commitment. She tackles the tough issues of sex with candor, insight and humour, with a challenge for young people to get the “abstinence advantage.”
- D-57 Hang on to Your H-H-H-Hormones Straight Talk** - 55 minutes
Bev Hadland speaks on chastity and secondary virginity as a positive alternative to the sex related problems of the 90s.

The art of presiding for Deacons and lay persons. Viewers learn the significance of the actions and words that constitute this ministry of public prayer.
- L-9 Training the Parish Lector** - 47 minutes
This program demonstrates both the right and wrong methods of delivery and provides a step-by-step approach to preparing for the ministry of lectoring. The theology of ministry is presented.
- L-10 Training the Eucharistic Minister** - 24 minutes
This program explains the responsibilities of the Eucharistic minister; the correct as well as incorrect methods of distributing the bread and wine.

- L-11 Training the Mass Server** - 41 minutes
Presents the duties servers perform for the Eucharistic celebration. Reinforces the value of the ministry.
- L-12 Let the Children Come to Me** - 71 minutes
Twelve short homilies. Examples of how simple props and active involvement of the “assembly of children” can help make the Word of God come alive in their minds and hearts.
- L-13 Death and Life: Preparing for the Catholic Funeral Mass** - 30 minutes, study guide included. Father Joseph Champlin. The beauty of liturgy and ritual demonstrates how the Church walks with those who mourn. Cults of saints and relics and an eagerness to accept the miraculous among the common people characterized popular religion. Monks and nuns preserved the scriptures by copying them by hand. And they reached out to the poor of society.
